We need an M.D. and an ultrasound technician to ramp up our readiness to perform the *limited diagnostic ultrasounds* that enable us to confirm pregnancies and give women insight regarding the precious reality of life in their wombs. As demand for our services increases, we are determined to meet the challenge. Your steadfast support is essential. Imagine riding a bicycle 100 miles per day for 6 consecutive days. Even if you're the qualifying 18 – 39 years young, it's still a daunting challenge, especially if you were not previously a cycling athlete, as our 2024 Biking for Babies Missionary Rider,

Amanda Nolan, a Boston resident, admits she was not — "I didn't even own a bike."


Yet, like her 8 teammates, she trained physically and spiritually to ride from Charlotte, North Carolina to Arlington, Virginia, July 8 – 13. They were among the 76 Missionary Riders whose teams conquered 8 different routes in several states to raise more than \$300,000 for 88 pro-life pregnancy resource centers in the U.S.

Amanda represented our center with outstanding love, awareness, eloquence, grace and cheerfulness from the moment she was partnered with us. Furthermore, she alone raised \$12,000 of the aforementioned aggregate that will be granted to the centers.

After visiting on June 12, Amanda wrote to her many supporters, "What a JOY it was to see the Center in action and meet the staff who are truly the hands and feet of Jesus to pregnant women and families in need. There is no limit to their devotion and generosity. No one is ever turned away, no situation is insurmountable, and they walk with their clients every step of the way.

They are angels among us and I'm so thankful to all of you for supporting their work through your donations and prayers."
